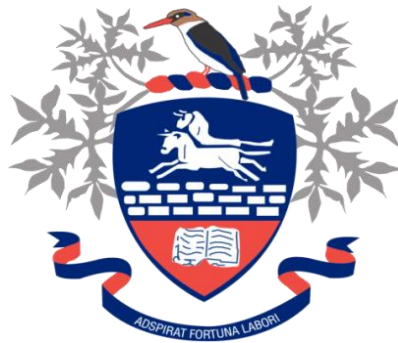

1.5 Modern trends have replaced cultural traditions [50]

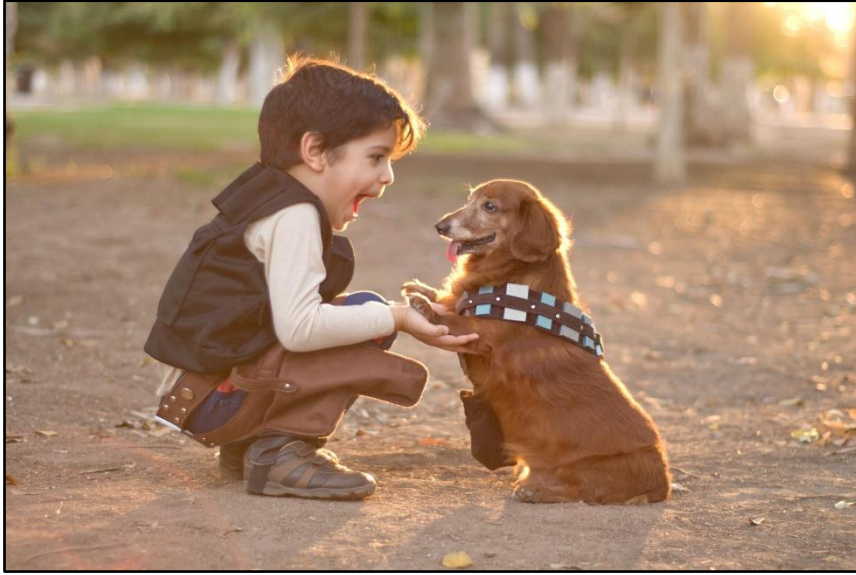

2.6 LETTER TO THE PRESS

'Witnesses' to Premier Sihle Zikalala's 'water tanker' debacle at his home, tell a different story

In a statement on Monday, Ravi Ramsundar, chairperson of the LMRCA, said that on April 15, 2022 at about 7:15pm, while residents were queuing for borehole water at a mosque about five metres away from the premier's home, situated in a cul-de-sac, a water tanker arrived. Ramsundar said the incident was witnessed by several members of the LMRCA who were on site as well as several residents, security at the mosque and those queuing for water. This had been the first time a water tanker had come to the area since the recent floods, he added.

"In full view of all those present, the water tanker proceeded to the home of the premier after which the driver offloaded the entire tanker for the exclusive use of the premier's home only.

"When queried, the driver advised that the water tanker was destined for Tongaat but that it was rerouted to the premier's home," said Ramsundar.

According to Giyapersad, he indicated residents were entitled to and had been offered water as well.

"This is factually incorrect as LMRCA and several informal dwellers who were [present] at the community hall proceeded to the truck for water, and [were] advised that the water was for Sihle only," said Ramsundar.
